The **Celommi Award** is the result of good cooperation among the educational institutions (Liceo "Delfico-Montauti", Liceo Scientifico "Einstein", IIS "Di Poppa-Rozzi" and IIS "Pascal-Comi-Forti" of Teramo, Liceo Artistico Grue of Castelli, IO "P. Levi" of Sant'Egidio alla Vibrata, IC of Torricella Sicura-Civitella del Tronto, IC of Montorio al Vomano, IC1 and IC2 of Roseto degli Abruzzi) and the non-profit organization Fondazione Pasquale Celommi Onlus. The Award consists of three categories (artistic, literary and historical) and the following competitions: the International Competition of Engraving and Sculpture, the National Artistic Competition, the Interregional Dantesque Certamen (Abruzzo, Marche) and finally the Regional Competition "Tell a story about the Resistance".

The different categories of this award have had important recognition and sponsorship so far: the High Patronage of the President of the Italian Republic, the High Patronage of the Regione Abruzzo, the Regional Education Authority of Abruzzo, the University of Rome *La Sapienza*, University of L'Aquila, University of Urbino *Carlo Bo*, University of Teramo, Academy of Fine Arts of Macerata, National Park Gran Sasso-Monti della Laga, the Ministry of Education Programme for the Enhancement of Excellences and a large number of Municipalities.

Notice of Competition and Regulations

Art. 1 – Organizers

The Liceo "Delfico-Montauti" of Teramo and the non-profit organization Fondazione Pasquale Celommi ONLUS, as part of the Celommi Award, hereby announce **The Biennial International Competition of Engraving and Sculpture**.

Art. 2 – Objectives and Applicants

The first edition of the Award deals with the theme of freedom, drawing from line 71 of the first canto of Dante's Purgatory "*in the search for Freedom, which is so dear...*"

The Competition consists of two sections:

- 1. Engraving**
- 2. Sculpture**

Artists of any age and nationality can apply, freely and individually for the first section. On the other hand, an invitation is needed to attend the second section. Each artist can carry out

his/her own work using any material he deems necessary.

Art. 3 – Participation Requirements

Engraving Section

Each participant may submit a maximum of three works and is required to send two copies and use the following techniques: burin, drypoint, etching, aquatint, soft-ground, mezzotint, woodcut and other traditional techniques used separately or in combination, in accordance with the artist's originality. During its printing phase, the image must be obtained by one or more engraved matrixes, either drawn or painted by hand. The artworks received will be acquired by Fondazione Pasquale Celommi, after which they will be inventoried, included and valorized in the Engraving Collection of Art and History Museum at "Villa Capuani-Celommi" in Torricella Sicura (Teramo).

Sculpture Section

This section is upon invitation only. The selected artists will send the photographs of the artwork they wish to participate with and the relevant information required for the Competition. The eligible artwork will be selected based on uncontested decision of the Jury.

Art. 4 Jury. Rules on Accession

The Jury, appointed by the Fondazione Pasquale Celommi ONLUS, will consist of famous national artists. The competition will be held at Liceo "Delfico-Montauti".

All the artwork submitted and eligible for the competition will be mentioned in a paper and digital catalogue which will be given free of charge to the artists involved. Participation in the competition implies the full acceptance of the present Regulation and this acceptance will be considered equivalent to the artist declaration, under his/her own personal liability, that the artworks are of personal production, exempting the Organizers from any possibility of third party liability. In addition, participants shall authorize the use of the works submitted for their display at the Exhibition and their reproduction in the Catalogue. The Organizers will have the right to use the photographs of the artwork eligible to participate in the competition, and thereby are allowed to reproduce, record and publish the same works.

Engraving Section:

The three pieces of artwork that are ranked in the first, second and third position will be reproduced in the catalogue, along with the first five honorable mentions of the Jury, with an image and a critical text. An additional one hundred pieces of artwork, will be reproduced with an image and accompanied by a short description. All shipment fees are to be paid by the participants.

Sculpture Section:

The three pieces of artwork that are ranked in the first, second and third position, together with the first three honorable mentions, will have their images reproduced with a critical text, whereas the other works will be reproduced with a picture and a short description. The artworks will be shipped and collected at the expense of the Fondazione Pasquale Celommi. Moreover, the delivery and collection dates will be agreed upon with the Curator of the Exhibition, who reserves the right to communicate the Opening Day in due time. Granted that the utmost attention will be taken during the exhibition, the organizers of the competition will be issued a special liability release for any damage which may occur during transport. However, the Organizers will be covered by an insurance policy during all the period of the exhibition.

Art. 5 – Awards and Ceremony

As a reward, **the Competition provides for the printing of a catalogue with a text drawn up by an art critic**, who is a member of the Jury. The catalogue, written in Italian and English, will also include other works and will make reference to all the participants. **The award ceremony and the presentation of the Catalogue will take place in Teramo, or in another place which will be communicated by the month of December.**

Art. 6 – Rules of the Competition

Participation in the competition implies the unconditional acceptance of all the rules established in this notice, in addition to all those established by the Italian law and regulations in force.

Art. 7 – Data Processing

In accordance with Legislative Decree dated June 30, 2003, n° 196, the Foundation commits itself to respect the confidential nature of the information provided by the applicants: all data provided will be treated solely for the aims related and complementary to the procedure for which this notice has been issued.
